



## Call for Artist-Educators

Theatre Direct is calling for submissions by professional Artist-Educators to join their teaching roster for the 2017-18 Season; with training opportunities in the 2016-17 Season.

Teaching Artists will primarily assist Theatre Direct with residencies and workshops which will include facilitating The Firefly Project: A Storytelling and Drama Residency for Kindergarten and Grade One.

Suitable candidates will have professional training and experience in drama and/or dance and/or music and/or puppetry and/or design and visual art and be skilled in working with children and youth ages 4-18.

Chosen candidates will be required to present a valid Vulnerable Sector Check from Toronto Police Services. Bachelor of Arts, Bachelor of Fine Arts and/or Bachelor of Education considered an asset. Priority will be given to applicants of a diverse background and to applicants who speak fluent French.

Training opportunities are available between January – March 2017. Training is mandatory and Theatre Direct will provide a modest honorarium for the artist's time.
