

Theatre Direct is accepting applications for Summer Drama Camp Counsellors!

This opportunity is ideal for individuals returning to post-secondary education in the fall and who are interested in theatre and/or education, and looking to gain experience working with children in a theatre setting. These positions are funded through the Canada Summer Jobs program.

The successful applicants will be employed as Counsellors for Summer Drama Camps for children ages 4 - 12 years. The Camp Counsellors will be responsible as supervisors and apprentice teachers to the students as well as being a first point of access and contact for parents and community members. Other responsibilities include assisting the professional theatre guest artists when they are running sessions, completing various reports, keeping the program areas clean and orderly, and ensuring a safe and inclusive environment for all.

Prior to the commencement of the camps, Camp Counsellors will be trained in: summer camp procedures, health and safety, teaching and supervision styles, communicating with parents and caregivers, and will work as a team to plan outdoor activities.
