POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

As with parents, your child's health and safety is our prime concern. Please understand that our policies and procedures have been created with your child's safety and well-being in mind.

Nut Policies

• We strive to be a nut-free environment here at Theatre Direct.

Illness

• Immediate care will be provided if your child becomes ill or injured while in class. We will contact you or your designated emergency contact as soon as possible and will make every effort to keep your child comfortable until your arrival. Please do not send your child to class if they have a contagious illness or a high fever.

Medication

• Please let us know if your child requires any prescribed or over the counter medications. If so please be as detailed as possible on our expanded information form.

Immunization

- In order to participate in Theatre Direct Programming we require that your child be immunized. We will ask for proof of immunization on the first day of your child's program. The health and safety of our students and community is very important to us. More information from Toronto Public Health can be found here:

Head Lice (pediculosis)

- Parents are required to keep their child at home until the problem is cleared.
- All parents of children in a class in which a child or children are found to have head lice (pediculosis) will be sent a memo informing them of that fact.

Inclement Weather

All programming will continue during inclement weather conditions. Appropriate dress
is required for all weather conditions. Indoor facilities are available for class all day,
every day during sessions. Should we need to cancel class due to extreme weather we
will make every effort to contact families in a timely manner.

Behaviour Expectations

 All participants are encouraged to create and play in an inclusive cooperative and safe environment. We build ensemble by promoting Cooperation, Participation, Respect with our Voices and Bodies, and Listening.

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• Staff at Theatre Direct work collaboratively and positively with your child at all times however, we should have any difficulties or challenges with behaviour we will speak directly to a parent.

Refund / Cancellation Policy

 Refund request must be made in writing to the office 2 weeks prior to the start of each session. Requests are eligible for full refund; however, a \$25 administration fee is applied to all cancellations. After this time, class fees are non-refundable, except for medical reasons (a doctor's note will be required).

Office

- The Theatre Direct Office is open from Monday to Friday, from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm, daily. You can contact the Office by calling 416-537-4191. Should the phones be busy, please leave a detailed message and office staff will return your call as soon as possible.
- Theatre Direct does not recommended parent "drop-in" visits to class in order to minimize distractions or interruptions to children and programming.

Tickets

- As a member of Theatre Direct's Drama School your child receives one free ticket to our shows when accompanied by an adult. A trip to the theatre will enhance and compliment your child's experience in drama class.
